WEST VIRGINIA SECONDARY SCHOOL ACTIVITIES COMMISSION

The West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission is a voluntary organization composed of public tax supported junior and senior high schools. The Commission has supervised and controlled interscholastic athletic, music (vocal and instrumental), speech, student council and non-school sponsored contests and certain other interscholastic activities.

The administration of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission is vested in the principals of its member schools who constitute a Board of Control.

The Commission is designed to provide means for the unbiased and amicable settlement of disputes regarding interscholastic activities of member schools. Order and cooperation has resulted in said activities by the secondary schools of the state.

The Wetzel County Board commends the Commission for its progress toward its stated objective, "To limit interscholastic programs as to both character and quantity to such activities and such events as may reasonably be looked upon as promoting the generally accepted objectives of secondary education and shall not unduly interfere with nor abridge the regular program of teachers and students in the performance of their regular day-to-day duties." The responsibilities and activities of the Commission are of such importance to the youth of our state that the said Commission deserves and requires formal recognition.

The Wetzel County Board of Education does hereby recognize the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission in principle and practice.

The Wetzel County Board of Education approves the secondary schools of Wetzel County to be governed by rules and regulations of the West Virginia Secondary School Activities Commission.
