~~ADVANCED COLLEGE PLACEMENT~~

~~Students who have completed their junior year of study may be admitted to West Virginia Northern Community College to enroll in not more than three courses per semester. To apply, the student must complete and comply with the regular college application form and procedures. In addition to being accepted into a program by West Virginia Northern Community College, the student must meet the following minimum criteria:~~

- ~~1) Be recommended by his/her principal or guidance counselor;~~
- ~~2) Be a senior;~~
- ~~3) Have a minimum of a B average;~~
- ~~4) Have his/her own access to the course(s) to be taken.~~

~~No advanced college work successfully completed may be used by a student for high school graduation requirements. Certain high school juniors (eleventh graders) may be admitted with the approval of the principal. High school juniors and seniors may also acquire college credit or advanced placement by successfully completing one or more of the Advanced Placement courses offered at each high school and by passing the College Board AP exam.~~
